



BID NOTICE UNDER INTERNATIONAL COMPETITIVE BIDDING (ICB)

1. The Government of Uganda through the Ministry of Agriculture, Animal Industry and Fisheries (MAAIF) has received funds from IFAD to be used for the acquisition of vehicles (LOT 1) and Motorcycles (LOT 2).
2. The Entity invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for supply of the above vehicles and motorcycles.
3. Bidding will be conducted in accordance with International Competitive Bidding method (ICB) contained in IFAD procurement guidelines

All bids must be accompanied by a bid security of Ugx. 190,000,000/= or equivalent in freely convertible currency for each Lot. All the Bid securities must be valid until 26th January 2018. Late bids shall be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives, who choose to attend at the address below at 8(d) at 11:10 on 1st September 2017.
